ATTENTION ALL DOG OWNERS June 1st is fast approaching!





The Town of Danbury Requires all dogs four months and older be licensed before April 30th. Regardless of when the license is obtained, the license is valid from May 1st of each year to the following April 30th. The cost to license a dog is \$9.00 for a male or female, \$6.50 for a spayed or neutered dog and \$2.00 if you are a senior citizen over 65 years of age. If a puppy is too young to be altered the \$6.50 fee will apply for the first license. Please bring proof of rabies with you.

According to RSA 466:13 additional fines will be incurred after June 1st.

Library News July 2019

The April issue of the NH Magazine included an article, "Ticked Off", which provides useful information about deer ticks and Lyme disease, as well as conversations with people who, having struggled with the disease, "are using their talents to make a difference". New in our cookbook collection is one written by Laura and Mary Piazza entitled "RECIPES FOR REPAIR, A 10-Week Program to Combat Chronic Inflammation and Identify Food Sensitivities". Laura suffers from chronic Lyme disease and has found relief from most of her symptoms by following the dietary advice of Dr. Kenneth Singleton who wrote the "The Lyme Disease Solution". The recipes were created to be family friendly and appealing to anyone. "No one needs to know that you're on a special diet," Laura says. "It's just dinner."

Dana Biscotti Myskowski's book "I CANNOT PLAY WITH YOU" is also now in the library. This Henniker resident has lived with Lyme disease symptoms since 2005. Wanting to raise awareness of the range of side effects and symptoms, and of what people who have the disease are going through, she discovered that there are already many self-help books about Lyme disease, so wrote a murder mystery instead. The main character investigates a murder while also trying to manage symptoms of chronic Lyme. With this first novel the author hopes to entertain as well as educate.

This summer's annual CHILDREN'S BOATING REGATTA is scheduled for Saturday, July 27th from 10 to 11:30am at the library. Participants will make and race paddle boats with their sailing mentor Tom Brewer. Adults are welcome to join the fun.

The Friends of the George Gamble Library continue to meet on the second Thursday of each month at 7pm in the Community Center. The big event of the summer is the library's annual BOOK SALE, held during the town wide yard sale across the street from the library, this year on Saturday, Aug 3rd.
