


2 pm - 3:30 pm: Gardeners & Nature Lovers -Creating Habitats for Birds, Bees & Butterflies

Library News - August 2019

The George Gamble Library is limited by special and financial constraints which, in turn, limits what we are able to offer our patrons. However, it is perhaps time to again remind you all of what is available within the walls of this special little building.

Of course there are BOOKS to borrow which include the most recent publications by patrons' favorite contemporary authors, as well as classics and books on gardening, cooking, crafts, etc. Books not on our shelves may be requested through the state interlibrary loan system.

Other materials available to borrow are: MAGAZINES - Consumer Report, Smithsonian, NH Magazine, Yankee and Web MD, AUDIO BOOKS, DVD's, PUZZLES and specialty CAKE PANS. As a public library, we also receive patron INFORMATION PUBLICATIONS from educational institutions, as well as calendars from NH Humanities and the Chapin Senior Center, the Parable magazine from the Catholic Diocese of NH, the NH RAP Sheet, which provides the latest in disability research, advocacy, policy, practice, and Stepping Stones NH, which is a guidebook for people with disabilities and their families.

WiFi is available during library hours, as well as a COMPUTER for public use and access to COPYING and FAXING documents. New and gently used books can be purchased with a donation, a thoughtful gift for family and friends because "A book is a chance to try on a different life for size" (Marion Garretty).

Most important of all, we offer a warm WELCOME to all who enter the door and with that welcome is the opportunity to greet neighbors and friends and perhaps even meet new people who will become forever friends.
