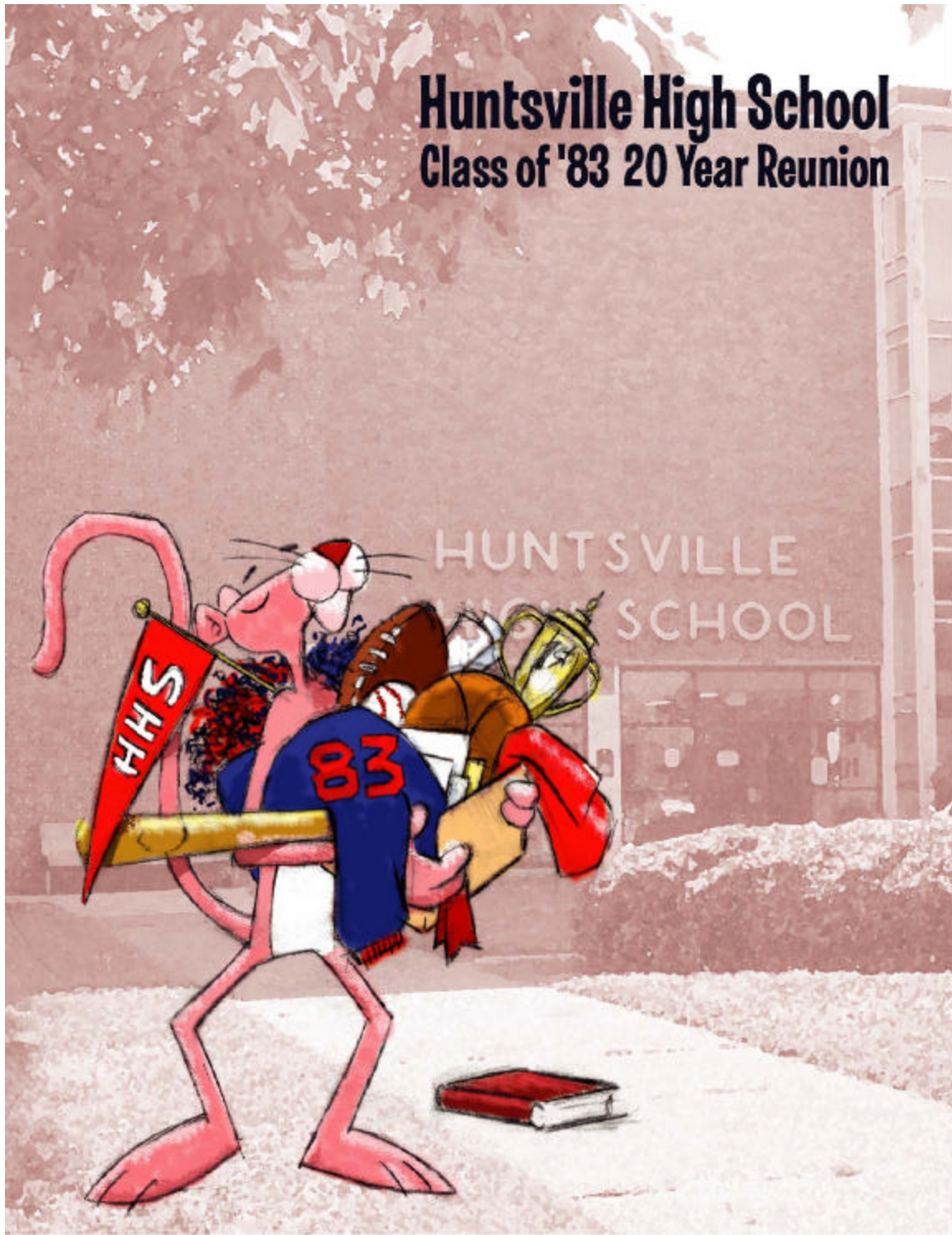

## Saturday Night June 21

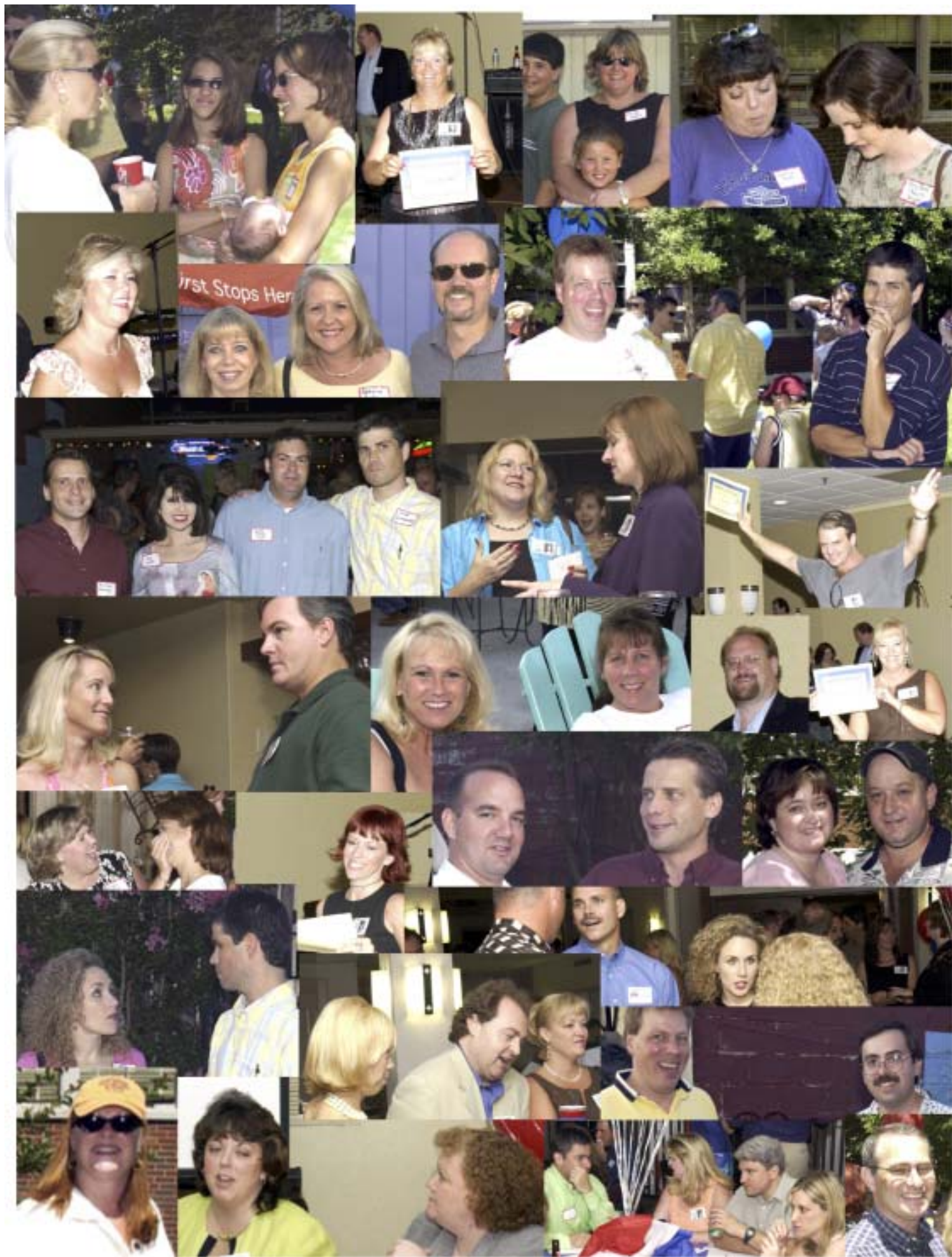

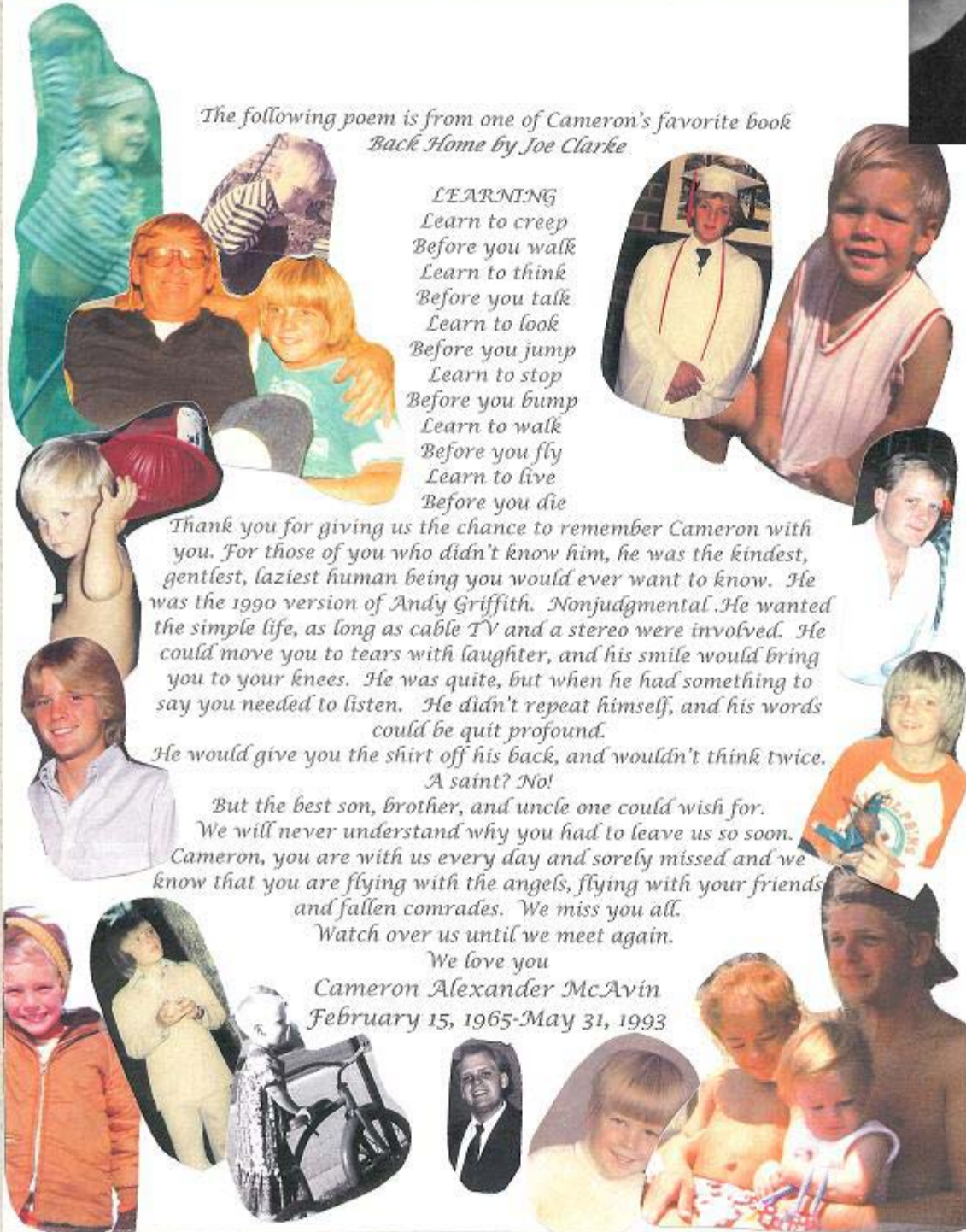
He would give you the shirt off his back, and wouldn't think twice.
