Fieldend Goes Digital

As you will no-doubt be aware, the analogue TV signal is being switched off in London in April 2012. means that if you are using an analogue TV receiver to watch TV, you will need to upgrade to a digital receiver in order to continue receiving a television signal after April 2012. Government has set up a digital website: switchover (DSO) www.digitaluk.co.uk which explains all about making the switch, what equipment you will need and the different options available.

Satellite Dishes

FRAL has been approached by a number of Fieldend residents who have asked whether they can install satellite dishes. Currently satellite dishes are not allowed in Fieldend. But your queries have prompted FRAL to consider whether we should relax the rules and allow satellite dishes. If we did change the rules, installation of a satellite dish would be subject to FRAL's approval but FRAL would not refuse unless the dish impacted the public appearance of Fieldend.

Because of rules brought in by Richmond Council last year to do with our status as a Conservation Area, Fieldend residents would also need to get planning permission for a satellite dish installed on a roof, façade or anywhere where it would be visible from the public areas of Fieldend.

We will be asking residents to vote at the next AGM in February 2012 on the following question: should satellite dishes be permitted in Fieldend, subject to FRAL board approval? We would like to know what you think about satellite dishes at Fieldend. Please send your written comments to a member of the board before the February AGM.

FRAL cannot recommend any particular digital option. More information is available on the government's DSO website or contact a local independent satellite engineer for a survey of your house.
