Lighting the way at Fieldend



Welcome to a new, brighter Fieldend! George and Mark Hammond have now completed the lighting upgrade. All the planned works to remove and reposition most of the old, obsolete and mismatched light units were achieved plus a couple of extra new features added. We now have 13 amp outdoor sockets next to the East Square, ideal for garden parties as well as for gardeners. Please use them thoughtfully. We also have a new LED light in the dark alley between nos 27 and 28. Many thanks to George and Mark, who quietly solved the many problems the job threw at them. Now we just need to get the Council to look after their lights properly!

Garden notes Tree works

Unfortunately, some of our beautiful silver birches planted in the 1960s

summer 2017 are coming to the end of their natural lives. We have had to remove three specimens that have died, but plan on replacing all these in the future. This has prompted us to ask Out There Trees (OTT, our

contractor) to review and update the 2016 tree survey. OTT is coming to Fieldend on 19 July to continue the non-urgent work recommended in the 2016 tree survey, and also on advice from the Tree Protection Officer (TPO) - to fell the silver maple tree adjacent to Newland House. Later in the summer the two large planes in East Square will be reduced (see picture, below, just after they were last pruned in 2007).



Richmond Council has adopted the large plane trees in Red Square; these will be reduced later this year.

As new trees and shrubs are planted, it is very important that they are watered regularly, even in the winter. Since our gardeners are not here all the time, it would be greatly appreciated if residents could keep an eye open for new plants and trees near their houses and water them when necessary.
