GARAGE UPDATE

Recently a power surge in the electrical supply to garages in the West Garage block caused the tripping of protection switches in many garages internal supplies. If you find you have lost power in your garage you will need to reset the trip switch or RCD button. They are

designed to be resettable without an electrician - If you have an electric garage door and cannot operate it you will need to unlock it with the manual Key to gain access to the fuse box to restore power. Please contact Theo at no 44 if you are in any doubt. about what to do.
