

## Sandy's Message:

### Oh! Now I Get It!

Have you had the experience of working with a teacher other than your usual one and during their teaching they describe a movement or give instruction in a slightly different way than you have heard before and you think, "Oh, that's what my teacher was trying to get me to understand. Now I get it!"

The more ways we teachers have to say the same thing or describe an action, the more likely we are to have students understand us. Just as several people may read the same book, or see the same movie, or hear the same lecture, they may come away with quite different points of view of what they experienced. We all perceive through our own filters which have been shaped by our environment, experiences, social conditioning, and other factors.

At a recent T'ai Chi Chih Teacher Symposium we shared the various ways we teach and say things. Stephen Thompson shared that during the front and back weight shifts he prompts his students to "bring the weight to the center of the foot – not an inch more, and not an inch less." Then we as a group explored how that felt to us and the various ways those particular words might help students with their weight shifts. For Around the Platter Variation try using the words "curve forward" in place of "circle forward" and see if that feels different.

We also discussed how the language we use to advertise and teach might be tailored to various groups.

The Teacher' Conference this year plans to have several breakout sessions where we look at the words we use in teaching: how can we increase our vocabulary to reach more students? Not only to help them to learn the form, but also to attract more diversity of gender, age, and color.

All those attending the Teacher Symposium found a wealth of new ideas not only to

bring back to our students, but also for enriching our own practice. Many of these ideas will be shared at conference. I look forward to the breakout sessions at conference this year to enhance my own practice, bulk up my teaching vocabulary, and gain new insights into ways of teaching T'ai Chi Chih. I hope you will join me there, too.


