CHANGE IN CONFERENCE SCHOLARSHIP PROCESS

Scholarships are available for those who need financial assistance to attend The 2016 T'ai Chi Chih Teacher's Conference in Seattle August 11-14. Please note there is a change in the way scholarship checks will be processed. Within one week of receipt of your scholarship application, notification of approval will be sent to you. Within two weeks of your notification, a check will be sent directly to you by postal mail service in the amount of your scholarship. If you have not yet made your registration with the University of Washington, you are expected to do so within one week of receiving your scholarship check. The new Scholarship Application Form (replacing the form currently posted) will be up on the TCC website mid April. In the mean time, you may use the form currently on the conference site, but know the above process applies. Application deadline for scholarships is July 7.
