## 2020 Roanoke-Benson FFA Antique Tractor Pull Rules Pull will start promptly at 9:30am

- 1. \$25 Hook-up fee per pull
- 2. Tractors must be operated with factory hand throttle. All engines must have properly functioning governor. Engine speed (RMP) limited to 10% over factory setting. All tractors are subject to random scale checks. <a href="Tractors must have stock block or equivalent replacement for that model.">Tractors must have stock block or equivalent replacement for that model.</a> (TSC power block, M&W type pistons, etc.,) Naturally aspirated. (Exceptions: Oliver Super 99GM, John Deere 435 GM.) No Nitrous bottles. No altered frame or rails or extended due to engine replacement. Except in 16000# Open Class.
- 3. All tractors Pull in 1st or 2nd gear unless otherwise instructed at the drivers meeting. Open class tractors may start in 2nd gear. No shifting while pulling, tractors with torque must be in place before pulling.
- 4. Max speed 4 mph for the 4500#-10500# Class 1959 and older. Max speed 8 MPH for classes 1960 and newer. 7500#, 8500# 10500# Non-turbo, 10500# turbo, 12500# Turbo, 16000# Open Class. If over speed limit automatic disqualification. NO EXCEPTIONS!!
- 5. The hitch hooking point will not be greater than 18 inches in height and stationery in all direction's antiques classes only. (Locked at 18" on tractor such as IH 2pt., Ford 3pt., etc.) Factory equipped drawbar and mounting must be used. Operator must furnish twisted clevis or bolt-on plow loop (factory or custom made) with 3-inch hole. Clevis or loop may be shimmed to achieve 20" 1960 and newer classes. The hooking point will be no less than 24" from center axle. Wheelie bars are optional. No hooking in front of draw bar must be in rear loop or clevis of drawbar.
- 6. Front weights will not be allowed to extend over 24" in front of tractor. Rear weights will be allowed behind rear axle. Not to extend past rear wheels/ radius of rear tire.
- 7. Each tractor will have two chances to start the sled within 50 feet.
- 8. No aggressive starts. Example: pulling the skid plate of the sled off the ground.
- 9. All tractors operated in unsafe manner on or off the tract will be disqualified.
- 10. Drivers must always remain seated and have one hand on the steering wheel and throttle all times.
- 11. Persons under the age of 16 must have a signed parental consent.
- 12. If the front wheels of the tractor are raised off the ground over knee high, you will be flagged.
- 13. Any tractor part that falls off while pulling/hooking will result in disqualification. As agreed by committee.
- 14. One tractor may pull one time in class. This may be changes at the discretion of the local pull committee.
- 15. May weight up for one extra class. 2 classes max. per tractor.
- 16. 2 Hooks per tractor.
- 17. Cheating: forfeit premium and disqualification. As agreed by committee
- 18. Decisions of the Judges, tech crews, and pull officials are FINAL.
- 19. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated.
- 20. Order of pull will be determined by drawing.
- 21. Changes made day of event take precedence over printed rules.
- 22. Drivers Meeting 15 minutes prior to start time.
- 23. SPEED WILL BE RADAR CHECKED IF SPEED IS OVER .2 on limit set for each class, YOUR OUT!!
- 24. NO ALCOHOL will be allowed on property. Anyone found with alcohol will be asked to leave and forfeit entry fee.
