Swap that Invasive Shrub for a Native One!

The Wild Rivers Invasive Species Coalition (WRISC) is hosting our fourth annual Invasive Species Trade-Up Days in May, with host locations in MI and WI. Trade-Up Days are an opportunity for landowners to remove an ornamental invasive shrub from their property, such as Japanese Barberry, Buckthorn, or Burning Bush, and exchange the plant for a monetary voucher to buy a native plant replacement. Each voucher is worth \$5, and you are able to receive up to \$50 if you bring in 10 or more invasive species! Vouchers are redeemable at participating greenhouses and plant sales for the purchase of a native plant. Customers are responsible for any price difference.
