There are times when we need some legal help to get through a "Life Issue", but we know it can be quite costly. There is a great resource available to us Veterans that many of us (including myself until recently)

do not know about. As I was looking for some help with a family matter and saw on the Mission Viejo Civic Center website something called <u>The Veterans Legal Institute</u>. I figured it was probably just some basic support with legal questions or something like that, however, to my surprise it actually provides help in many areas. I decided to go to their website <u>www.vetslegal.com</u> and I was amazed at the support available and it is PRO BONO (no charge)!

To take advantage of this service you only need to send them a copy of your DD-214 to prove you are a Veteran. Once they confirm it, you can start using their services. When I was approved, I chose the area of expertise I needed support with and just one day later I was assigned an Attorney who followed up with me to start discussing the help I needed! Life can get complicated at times with legal issues, but for us Veterans here is a great resource to help us. Go check them out and put your mind at ease because **Help is On the Way.**
