Becky had a CT scan on Thursday, got the results on Friday. The general surgeon called to tell her she did have a hernia but had cancer too. Her first appointment was on October 19th, 2023, with her oncologist. Becky never thought she would be going through this. You know it happens to others, not you!! Never could be so wrong.
