PCFTA – May 14, 2019

In attendance were Ron Shewmaker, Candy new, Emilie Hayhurst, Karen & Charles Rayside. Ron first discussed Good news about a meeting he had with Ed Campi. He showed us copies of documents and pictures he presented to him. They discussed the fact that Curcio has put up fencing after we cleared the trail, blocking the ROW again. Candy noted that we have cut the fence to remove it 3 times, and Curcio has put it back up everytime in the last few weeks. Per Ron, Ed is informed and will be getting involved in this. He and Ed also discussed the Galloping Gardens area near the Humane Society. Ron discussed with Mr Campi about moving the gate, but he would like us to ride the area first to see if we can get past the gate with horses, he again presented us with pictures. Candy agreed and will report back.

Ron discussed that the Legal Resolution for the blocked ROW's is supposed to be ready by June. It should be presented to the Board for a vote soon after. We think we will have 3 votes of YAY, which is what is needed. If it passes this should really start the ball rolling, with notices going out to all those who have ROW's Blocked. Keep fingers crossed. Ron is trying to get another meeting set up with Campi and his staff to discuss priority trails in need of clearing.

Membership is at 25 paid members right now. (4 of those were paid by the new Paypal system). Charles discussed that we can now send out invoices via email to those who have still not paid, and hopefully generate some more payment activity. Everyone agreed it was a good idea, so Karen and Charles will work on that. Review of 2018 showed 29 members paid.

Emilie asked about an update on the trail sign as promised by Canopy Property Managers. Karen discussed she had a meeting about 6 weeks ago, all went well and they liked the mock up sign we made. They were supposed to send it off to be printed and 2 signs will be erected on Boatramp, at 714 & Busch street. Karen will follow up to see if there is a date it should be completed. I am attaching the Mock up sign we presented to them for printing.
