PCFTA Meeting Notes

March 22, 2022 - Called to order 7 PM

Officer Present: Charles & Karen Rayside, Candy New, Cindy Stein & Judith Hamilton, 11 members total.

Ike Crumpler was a surprise guest and talked for a few minutes to the group about a proposed Atlantic Ridge Entrance in Hope sound and about new meetings coming up. He would like our support and we thanked him for helping us secure the new meeting location at New Beginnings Church.

Charles asked about nominees for the board position vacancy with Randee Sharpe moving out of town. Sybil Suggested we get revised to only 7 board members since 2 are basically non active.

Karen Gave financial report on member dues coming in \$550 thus far Plus \$100 collected at the meeting. (3 new members) Board members voted and decided to cancel constant contact as it is too costly. We now have a bank balance of \$9,274.99.

New Business

We set a trail clearing date of May 22nd, and the board voted we could spend up to \$400 paying for labor. A motion was made to Donate \$500 to the Cindy Reddish Benefit fund and all board members approved. Karen asked if anyone was interested in participating in a Tail Winds Easter Event, and all members declined. We set a group trail ride Date for May 28th at Atlantic Ridge Park. Sibyl will check with Ike Crumpler to see if we could possibly use the facility in Hobe Sound.

Old Business

Charles Talked about the Countess Joy Property. We helped design a trail system back in December and the Attorney gave it to Davis Goodfriend for review. Last week the attorney was supposed to be following up on that. We talked about two code violations that were turned into code enforcement by members. One on 33rd by the Geo Crossing, the other one is on 66th. Elisa Ackerly and Cindy Stein will follow up. Sibyl talked about a friend who got a letter from a neighbor and is trying to secure a ROW through abandonment process, was hoping to speak to Ron this.

We spoke to Melonie Trueman at the end of the meeting and she may be interested in the board position. We will follow up with her.
