The Grange Mutual Insurance Brad Keeton Memorial Scholarship Application

In 2022, the Oklahoma State Grange started the Brad Keeton Memorial Scholarship. Being such an influential and long-standing member of the Grange, we wanted to offer a chance for young men and women of our communities to receive a helping hand when it comes to furthering their goals of higher education, which was something very close to Brad's heart.

Once a year, a single recipient will be chosen amongst applicants to receive this scholarship totaling \$2,500. Eligible applicants include any Fourth Degree member in the Oklahoma State Grange that is pursuing higher education.

To apply, a completed application and a typed 500-word essay on how the scholarship will assist them in their goals for the future. These documents must be submitted by May 1st of the calendar year. Please mark your emails with a subject line that denotes this is for the Brad Keeton Scholarship.

The winner will be notified in advance and will be presented with their scholarship at that year's State Session. Payment of the scholarship is contingent on proof of acceptance and enrollment of the student at an accredited school by official statement from the Registrar's office. Winners are required to attend the Oklahoma State Grange session Saturday Evening during the degree work .to receive the funds. Once a scholarship is awarded, the recipient is not eligible to apply again. (Application is on the next page.)
