Located just 90 minutes from New York City in the scenic heart of Ulster County, Stone Dock is located on 68 lush, gently rolling acres, surrounded by farms, forests, Shawankunk Mountains and nearly a mile of the Rondout Creek. It is adjacent to the historic hamlet of High Falls and the 19th century 100+ mile D&H Canal, where bluestone and other goods were loaded onto barges from our site's "stone dock" and traveled to the Hudson River and beyond.
