Tanach = “Original (*Old*) Covenant”

Old (*original*) Covenant
explained in the
New (*Renewed*) Covenant

Messianic New Covenant - “Brit Chadashah”

Brit = Covenant Chadashah = new (*restored*)

Yeshuah and the Tanach

Lu 24:25 And He said to them,
O fools and slow of heart to believe all things that the prophets spoke!
26 Was it not necessary for the Christ to suffer these things
and to enter into His glory?

Lu 24:27 And beginning at Moses Torah
and all the prophets, Nevi'im
He expounded to them in all the Scriptures Chetu 'vim
the things concerning Himself.

expounded – *diermeneo* (G1329) = *to explain thoroughly*

Phillip and the Tanach

Ac 8:35 Then Philip opened his mouth
and began at the same Scripture
and preached the gospel of Jesus to him.

Gospel – euaggelizo (G2097) = to announce or declare good news

Paul and the Tanach

Ac 17:1 And traveling through Amphipolis and Apollonia, they came to Thessalonica, where there was a synagogue of the Jews.

2 And according to Paul's custom, he went into them and reasoned with them out of the Scriptures on three sabbaths,

3 opening and setting forth that Christ must have suffered, and to have risen again from the dead;

and that this Jesus whom I preach to you is Christ. (*declared the "Good News"*)

reasoned – *dialegomai* (G1256) = *to say or discuss thoroughly*

Ac 18:28 For he mightily confuted the Jews publicly,
proving by the Scriptures that Jesus was the Christ.

confuted – diakatelegchomai (G1246) = to prove or convince downright

proving – epideiknumi (G1925) = to exhibit or show

Ac 28:23 And they having appointed him a day,
many came to him in his lodging;
to whom he expounded,
testifying the kingdom of God,
and persuading them the things concerning Jesus,
both out of the law of Moses and out of the prophets,
from morning until evening.
24 And some indeed believed the things that were said,
others did not believe.

persuading - peitho (G3982) = to assure or convince

Yeshuah explained everything concerning Himself from the Tanach

Phillip declared the “Good News” about Yeshuah from the Tanach

Paul

- Discussed thoroughly the “Good News” about Yeshuah from the Tanach *Ac 17:2*
- Publicly Showed and convinced people about Yeshuah from the Tanach *Ac 18:28*
- Assured and convinced all who came to him concerning Yeshuah and His kingdom *Ac 28:23*
