# The Days of Saul and David

6 as far as **Melchizedek Ge 14:18-20** <sup>6</sup> as far as the wilderness.

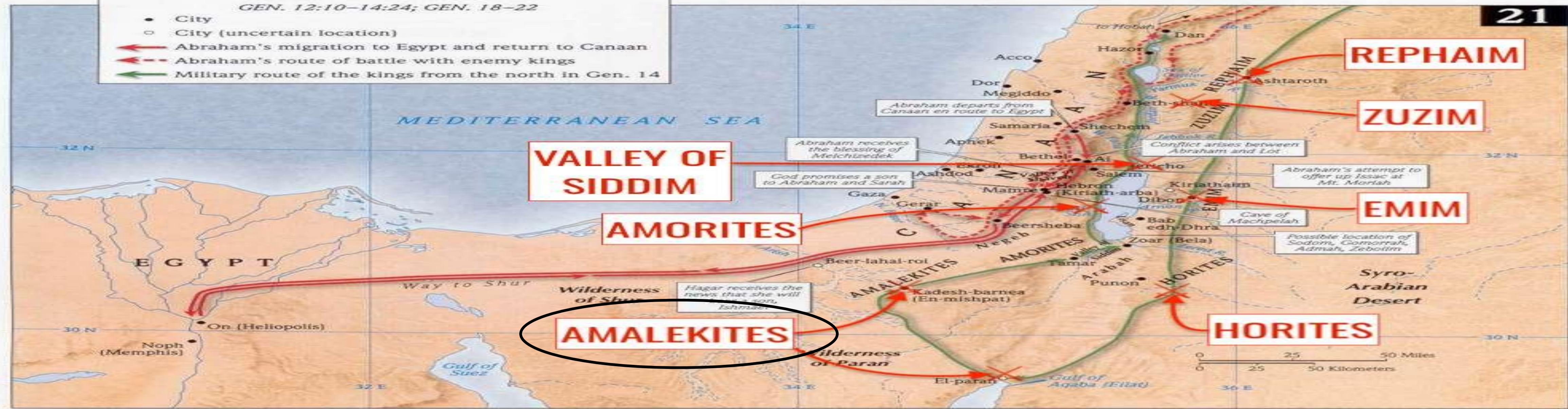
7 And they returned, and came to En-mishpat, which is Kadesh,
