2023-2024 Deadlines for Trinity County, Texas Elections

Tuesday, September 12, 2023: First day to file for a place on the Primary ballot for precinct chair candidates.

Saturday, November 11, 2023: First day to file for a place on the Primary ballot for all other candidates for all other party offices.

Saturday, November 11, 2023: First day to file for a place on the Primary ballot for party nomination for all U.S., Texas, and Trinity County elected offices.

Saturday, November 11, 2023: First day for independent candidates to file Declaration of Intent

Saturday, December 11, 2023, <u>at 6:00 p.m.</u>: Last day to file for party offices on the Primary ballot.

Saturday, December 11, 2023, at 6:00 p.m.: Last day to file for party nominations for U.S., Texas, and Trinity County elected offices.

Saturday, December 11, 2023, at 6:00 p.m.: Last day for independent candidates to file declaration of intent.

Monday, January 1, 2024: First day to apply for a ballot by mail using Application for a Ballot by Mail (ABBM) or Federal Post Card Application (FPCA).

February 5, 2024: Last Day to Register to Vote.

February 20, 2024: First day of Early Voting.

February 23, 2024: Last day for application for ballot by mail to be **received** by Elections Administrator. Postmarks for this day are not sufficient if application is not received on this date.

March 1, 2024: Last day for Early Voting.

Tuesday, March 5, 2024: For mailed ballot, the deadline is Tuesday, March 5, 2024 (Election Day) at **7:00 p.m.** if carrier envelope is **not** postmarked, **OR** Wednesday, March 6, 2024 (next business day after Election Day) at **5:00 p.m.** if carrier envelope is postmarked by 7:00 p.m. at the location of the election on Election Day (unless overseas or military voter deadlines apply).

Tuesday, March 5, 2024: Primary Election day. Last day to vote in person. Must be at voting precinct where voter is registered.

Tuesday, May 28, 2024: Runoff Primary Election day.

Tuesday, November 5, 2024: General Election day.
