

## **Tenney Park Lagoon Shoreline Restoration**

Eco-Resource Consulting, Inc. (ERC) was commissioned by the City of Madison Engineering Division to oversee a complete shoreline restoration project. This three-year project included removal of woody and herbaceous invasive species, shoreline regrading, shoreline armoring, and the installation of 16,445 native trees, shrubs, and herbaceous plants (plugs) within shoreline and near-shore locations in the park. ERC maintained and monitored the restored native plant communities for two growing seasons following installation. The lagoons' shorelines have been stabilized and deep- rooted native plants continue to reduce sediment and nutrient transport, significantly improving water quality within the lagoons and within outflow water that flows into the Yahara River.
