Kevin started the meeting with Scripture and prayer.

1 Financials-Michele reported FW is in the black as Net Income for Jan-Dec 2023-this is great news!! Michele made a motion to 'sweep' the Edward Jones Growth Account to withdraw earnings to be applied to the Gerth Property account, but still maintain the Principal of \$500,000 in the Growth account. Gene 2nd to open for discussion. Motion passed.

2 SPRC-Gene reported that Jenna made a list of key tasks she does in her role, in preparation of unexpected absence or vacation. Board discussed who would be the person to fill in for Jenna in these circumstances.

3 Trustees-Andrew reported there is an issue with the Lift door. Trustees approved to get the door fixed-Board agrees & approved. Upcoming projects in 2024: New lights in the Fellowship Hall, Sidewalk, Hallway brickwork. It was decided that the Monitor for inside the Sanctuary will come from Worship funds. Andrew will connect with Joel on casting Service from You Tube vs Facebook. Michele recommended changing the phone service from VOIP to a new phone Service-this will enable paying Federal payroll taxes and using the church's phone number for continuity and ease in passing the Treasurer position thru the future years. Approval via Andrew(Trustees) was given to Michele to pursue this change to the extent it did not surpass current telecommunication expenses by 'much' or, at least, within reason. AND, if that required new telephones; the item will be open for discussion of any additional expense(s) via e-mail back to the Board.

4 Linda inquired with the Board about interest in an Annual Board Retreat for planning short and long term goals. The Board agreed and are tentatively setting aside April 20, 9am-12 noon. Scott has graciously agreed to host the Retreat at his home.

5 Michele inquired if a new Church Credit Card could be obtained. A new credit card will be obtained with the church's name instead of a persons name-Michele will follow up on this. Also Scott made a motion to add Michele as an authorized person on both Edward Jones accounts, Gene 2nd, motion passed.

Meeting was adjourned.




