I pray that your Lenten journey has been a good one thus far! Today as I write this article it is Ash Wednesday and Valentine's Day. I am glad these two days happen to share the same day this year! Both of these important days are about the heart, about love, more specifically sacrificial love. Saint Valentine was martyred on this day Feb 14, 270AD for sharing the Gospel of Christ with the Emperor Claudius II Gothicus. He gave his life for the sake of sharing the saving grace and love of Christ. Ash Wednesday is the day where we prepare our Lenten discipline of prayer and fasting as we walk with Jesus and the disciples to Jerusalem, the cross, and the tomb. Jesus gave his life in love for us that we might have eternal abundant life. Valentine was just following the example of Jesus and the Christians who went before him, laying down his life for the sake of love. The love that we remember tonight is a sort of sacrificial love that breaks down barriers.

four men who brought their paralyzed friend to Jesus. This is a story about love, forgiveness, and healing! They loved their friend so much that they thought that if they could bring him to Jesus; he would be healed. When they got there to where Jesus was, they found their way blocked by a huge crowd that was surrounding a small house. This might have been the place they said to their broken friend "well, we tried', 'well, we will just have to try another day', or perhaps 'oh well, it was not meant to be." But for the sake of love they did not give up, they broke through the barriers of the crowd and the little small house! They managed to get their friend on the roof top, they clawed their way through the thatch and mud roof, and they lowered their friend to Jesus! They broke through the barriers! Jesus saw this man and their faith and declared that the paralyzed man's sins were forgiven, and to get up and walk. The religious elite were there erecting an invisible barrier of selfrighteousness in that Jesus did not have the authority to forgive sins (even though he did as God). Jesus broke through their barrier with love and the man was forgiven and healed.

The key point of this story is that we as Christians ought to break down barriers so that people can meet Jesus. We should break down the visible and invisible barriers in our own lives so that people can see Christ. Our lives should not be a barrier to Christ, rather a billboard proclaiming that in Jesus we have forgiveness, newness of life, hope, joy, and eternal life! The church must break down barriers so that the message can connect with people. In short we must be like those four friends who tore through the barriers to bring their friend to Jesus! May we do likewise – In Christ's Name! Amen!


