Faith Fest '24 Update: It is now time to begin signing up for the various committees to help at Faith Fest '24. The committees are:

Food – 10-15 people – in shifts (includes assisting 4-H as needed, set up, clean up of grounds during event) **Set-up/clean-up** – 25-30 people (includes setting up tents/canopies in various areas, assisting areas with tables, chairs, garbage cans, water coolers/ice, help-

ing carry food to 4-H bldg. if used, setting up grills if needed

Security/parking – 10 people – in shifts (includes assisting Mille Lacs Sheriff with security on the grounds and a security table at the entrance.) Coolers, diaper bags and back packs will be allowed but must be searched. All attendees will need to sign a waiver of liability also.

Entertainment – 4 – 6 people (includes helping to set up the stage for the live entertainment and guest speakers, announcing in between entertainment events, announcing free drawing winners,

Silent Auction – 4-6 people (in shifts) includes set up, assisting people with questions; closing and tabulating bids, collecting bids and clean up at end of event)

Merchandise sales – 6-8 people in shifts (includes set up; and working with POS credit card machine, collecting funds, assisting customers and clean up)

Community Resources – 1-2 people – (includes directing resources people where to set up; they have their own equipment and are told to do their own set up)

Prayer area – 1-2 people – (includes assisting pastors with set up and clean up)

Children's activities. 8-16 people (Each of the large tents will take at least 8 people to set up – the tents are 20 x 20; set up tables and chairs as needed.

Guest services – 2-4 people in shifts – (includes set up, clean up and answering any questions, handing out programs, handing out drawing tickets and wrist bands to children, writing phone number on wrist band of parents in case of lost child, handing out bags for children's crafts, will be set up next to the security table at entrance,

Floaters – 5-10 volunteers – will "float" around the venue to assist at any time as needed, answer any questions for attendees, other misc. duties as needed

ALL volunteers will receive a FREE purple Faith Fest t-shirt.

God wants us to live in His Truth, which leads us to peace, joy, hope, stability in an unstable uncertain confused world. This is what I seek to teach and to profess as your pastor. Why? It is for the sake of love! I love you those of you who are part of this community of Freshwaters – and I want nothing more than to share with you God's Truth for the sake of love and abundant life. 


