**For anyone who finished a title on a dog in 2020, Cathy needs the following:**

Please remember the following:

Only AKC titles get plaques.

Non-AKC titles get certificates.

*"Approved and Revised: March 2018 CKC Standing Rules.*

5. *Only Active members are eligible for the following:*

- A. *A plaque awarded by the club at the Awards dinner commemorating the first title won by the owner's dog. (Multiple plaques can be won by an owner, but only one is awarded per dog.)*
  - 1). *Subsequent titles/accomplishments for that dog(s) will be recognized by plates that are meant to be attached to the original plaque.*
  - 2). *Note: "non-active" members will receive recognition for their dogs' titles/accomplishments in the form of a Certificate awarded by CKC.*

4. *Members will be considered "Active" members if they meet the following criteria:*

- A. *They must be considered a "member in good standing" (i.e., dues are up-to-date and no additional moneys are due to the club)*
- B. *A minimum of 5 meetings must have been attended during the calendar year unless they have an "excused" absence, such as work, out of town, weather or illness. Notify Recording Secretary of excused absences.*
- C. *They must have actively served on at least one committee during the year."*

If you would like a plaque or a bar but are not considered an active member Cathy would be happy to get you the price to purchase one with the clubs order.

### What to do:

Activity One: Have your child or grandchild write a letter to Santa from their dog.

Activity Two: Use 3-D Dog cards by Kikkerland to play War. Name a breed or two as you play. (I got my card from Curiosities in Ft. Collins.) How to play War: Card are shuffled, dealt and placed face down in a stack in front each player. Each player turns over a card at the same time. The highest card takes all the cards. If the highest cards have the same rank, those players have a "war." Each of those players turns one card faced down and once card face up. High cards wins all the cards. Play continues until all cards are played. Player with the most cards wins!
