## CITY OF WAUWATOSA UPDATES

Bids for the installation of the flashing crosswalk beacons at 83<sup>rd</sup> St. and North Ave were opened during the last week of September. Contractually, the work must be completed by November 10. If all goes smoothly, this project will finally be completed this fall!

Bike lanes have been added along North Ave providing increased connectivity with the previously marked lanes east of Wauwatosa Ave. The bike lanes are for the exclusive use of bicyclists; they are not parking or passing lanes. Motorists should expect that cyclists are moving in the direction of the traffic.
