Cardiologist). While we try to accommodate preferences, families do not choose the puppy. We choose the puppy based on our long time experience in what we feel is the best puppy for your family's individual needs/circumstances and lifestyle so that not only is the puppy happy, but also you and your family. This also includes if you are inquiring about an adolescent or retired adult.
