B-22:

E-22-B:

This unit is currently being serviced at Siddons for repairs then will be placed on the market for sale.

E-22:

This Apparatus is currently in service at Station 2.

T-21:

This unit is currently in service and fully operational. No issues noted.

M-21 (New Medic Unit):

This unit is currently in service at Station 2, it was taken to Billy Bob's mechanic shop for servicing of the exhaust system, brake change.

M-22:

The unit is O.O.S. service at Station 1, repairs have been made by Siddons and ready to be sold. All medical equipment has been removed from this unit.

M-23:

The unit is being checked weekly and is our backup Medic unit.

Rescue 22:

Apparatus is being checked daily and is in service. This unit is still being utilized as a temporary Command.

MISC:

The 3M Scott SCBA equipment was delivered 2 weeks ago. In servicing/Training was completed on all shifts. E-22 had 4 new SCBA Packs placed in the unit and Tender 21 has 3.
