### **Monthly Command Report**

### For June Emergency Response:

For the month of June, there were a total of 46 fire calls.

For the month of June, there were a total of **62 911** EMS calls, **35** transports and **27** non-transports. Of the transports, there were **22** ALS and **13** BLS calls.

In addition, there were 19 facility transfers completed.

For the month of June there were a total of 81 EMS runs.

ALS- Advanced Life Support

BLS- Basic Life Support

Average response time for the month was 07 minutes and 22 seconds. This is door-to-door time.

## **Emergency Vehicles:**

**<u>B-22:</u>** Apparatus is being checked daily and is in service. The brake system will soon need to be serviced.

**B-21B** (New Heavy): Apparatus is being checked daily without major issues to report.

2 ½ Ton 22 B: Apparatus has been donated to Blackhill VFD and is no longer a part of our fleet.

**E-22:** No change in status. We are awaiting an appraisal from Siddons for a possible trade in for the new Engine/Tender.

**E-21:** Apparatus is being checked daily without any major issues to report. We are currently weighing options to retain this apparatus in the fleet instead of trading it in. The pull string on the chainsaw located in the Driver 2 compartment failed and needs to be replaced.

<u>Loaner Engine:</u> Apparatus is being checked daily without any major issues to report. The exhaust system near the turbo failed, Siddons was contacted to conduct the repair.

<u>T-22:</u> Apparatus is currently out of service and at Siddons. The 104 Point inspection has been completed and the board is working on trading the apparatus in towards the new pumper/tender and retaining Engine 21.

<u>M-22</u>: The unit is being checked daily and is in service without any major issues to report, currently positioned at Station 1 as a reserve unit. This allows us to keep EMS in service when another unit is down for service.

<u>M-23:</u> The unit is being checked daily and is in service without any issues to report. The unit is positioned at Station 2 as a 911 MICU.

<u>M-21 (New Medic Unit):</u> The unit is being checked daily and is in service as the primary 911 MICU at station 1. The unit is starting to drive rough & will potentially need new tires. Tires are 2018 and due to be replaced.

**Rescue 22:** Apparatus is being checked daily and is in service. This unit is still being utilized as a temporary Command. The unit is being scheduled for AC service at 181 Auto in July.

#### MISC:

Crews are working to finalize the updated pre plans and audit hydrants and standpipes we have built into our electronic mapping and making any appropriate updates. We are planning to begin ISO survey preparation meetings with our rep starting in August.

The new Engine was spec'd specifically to aid in a positive manner with the new ISO survey.

## **Personnel:**

Chief Officers have continued to work shift vacancies assigned to apparatus, when possible, in effort to keep overtime costs down. We are currently working on increasing our number of local volunteers.

#### **Administration**:

Admin staff is in process of compiling budget items for FY24.
