Monthly Command Report For August Emergency Response:

- For the month of August, there were a total of **15 fire** calls.
- For the month of August, Fire units first responded to Asst. D2 EMS on 40 calls.
- For the month of August, there were a total of **53 911** EMS calls, **32** transport's and **21** non-transports.
- In addition, there were **0** facility transfers completed.

Emergency Vehicles:

- **<u>B-22:</u>** Apparatus is being checked daily and in service. The brake system will soon need to be serviced and an oil change is needed.
- **B-21 (New Heavy):** Apparatus is being checked daily without major issues to report.
- **E-22-B:** This unit is not operational due to many issues with it. It has been placed O.O.S.
- **E-22:** Apparatus is being checked daily without any major issues to report. The pull string on the chainsaw located in the Driver 2 compartment failed and needs to be replaced.
- <u>T-21:</u> This unit has been placed in service and is fully operational. It has already responded to multiple fire calls.
- <u>M-21 (New Medic Unit):</u> This unit has started to leak oil while parked in the bay. It was sent to Siddons for repairs, this unit requires an oil change as well.
- <u>M-22</u>: The unit is being checked daily and is in service without any major issues to report, currently positioned at Station 1 as a reserve unit.

<u>M-23:</u> The unit is being checked daily and is in service without any issues to report. The unit is positioned at Station 2 as a 911 MICU. This unit requires an oil change and new vehicle batteries.

Rescue 22: Apparatus is being checked daily and is in service. This unit is still being utilized as a temporary Command. This unit requires an oil change.

MISC:

We postponed the ISO audit. If the survey is completed while making these changes, it will negatively affect the outcome.

Personnel:

We're currently working on increasing staff of local volunteers. We've also secured 3 part-timers within the Dept. to each work on a full-time shift to supplement staffing. They will begin October 1st.

Administration:

I'm continuing the transitional process with the change in Head of Department. I've started to assist Brenda in compiling paperwork/Invoices for our end of year audit.

Stations:

Crews have started to "Spring Clean" both Stations. No major issues have been reported by staff. There are minor things that need to be fixed. Station 1 kitchen sink faucet leaks water when closed.

<u>Grants/Donations:</u> I have been working with the Forestry service through Fire Connect on grants for classes. We did receive a 10,000.00 Dollar grant for training equipment. Our Chief Training Officer is looking at what training items are needed within the Department.
