Monthly Command Report

For December 2019

Emergency Response:

For the month of December, there were a total of **23** fire calls. Average response time for the month was **7** minutes and **00** seconds. This is a door to door time. Average response time increased this month due to responding to multiple mutual aid calls. Additional information can be viewed in the all in one report for the month.

For the month of December, there were total of **44** EMS calls with **27** Transports and **17** non- transports. Of the transports, there were **21** ALS and **6** BLS calls.

Emergency Vehicles:

B-90: Ignition switch was replaced by Atascosa Dodge. Siddons is sending a new circuit board for the light board due to operational issues.

B-91- New tires will need to be ordered in January.

5-TON/B92: Unit is being checked daily and is operational without any major issues to report.

2 ½ Ton/B93: Unit is being checked daily without any major issues to report. New headlights were installed in house with, in stock parts.

E-90: Unit had annual pump, hose, and ladder testing completed by Axxcess hose, and did pass the pump test. The unit will go to Siddons for its annual PM in January.

E-91: Unit went to Siddons for annual PM and pump test. Air leak, and valve seals were repaired so that unit could pass its pump test. Annual Hose and ladder testing were completed by Axxcess Hose.

T-90: Unit had annual hose, ladder, and pump tests completed by Axxcess Hose, and did pass its pump test. The unit will be scheduled for its annual PM in January at Siddons. Both batteries also had to be replaced.

M-90: Unit went to Ancira Ford to have the DEF sensor replaced.

M-91: Unit is being checked daily without any major issues to report.

Rescue 90: The heater hose broke and was repaired in house.

Administration:

District 2 has renewed its Health insurance with United Health Care and Dental and Vision with Principle. Employee Health and retirement meetings are being set for January.

Officer meetings were held on on December 3rd, December 9th, and December 27th. These meetings included the regular monthly meeting along with operational meetings for stations 1 & 2, to ensure smooth operations and address areas in need of improvement.

Training:

Fire: Regular training is conducted each day as a requirement. Crews train on specific skill sets specific to crew needs. The department training coordinator completes uniform and scheduled training with all shifts at least once every 2 weeks for approximately 4 hours per shift. For the month of December, Bexar County ESD 10 joined District 10 personnel for training over the following:

Hose line deployment & advancement

Ladder deployment

Team Master streams

Combination and transitional fire attacks

EMS: For the month of December, Bexar County ESD 10 joined District 2 personnel to train on the department's blood warmer, whole blood administration, and protocols in preparation for District 2 to go live with carrying whole blood.

Station:

Personnel are now staffed 24/7 at stations 1&2 and have been training on new response plans to ensure the best response for the community. For the month of December our response time greatly improved due to operations out of both stations shortening response times.

Grants/Donations:

We are currently working on grants for gear, SCBA's, radios, payroll, and apparatus. Department Christmas shirts were made available to the public, with all proceeds to go towards the meals for staff on duty for holidays. Thanks to this, the on duty Christmas crew was able to have a nice full meal.

Public Relations

On December 7th, Department apparatus and personnel joined the Floresville North Elementary for their Christmas fun run event.

On December 14th we hosted our first annual Christmas toy drive, with all toys being donated to the Wilson Area Children's Foundation. For the event we had pictures with Santa, AirLife Present, and an inflatable obstacle course for children. The event was a huge success, and we were able to have great interaction with the community.

Fire/EMS Prevention:

Fire: Due to a prolonged burn ban period, the department is using it as an opportunity to educate the public about proper outdoor burning regulations, as well as assisting them with obtaining a permit if they wish.

EMS: Department SMOPs (Standard Medical Operating Protocols) are currently being updated and converted to flow charts, one at a time. Once all protocols are converted to flow charts, they will be uploaded to a mobile application.

Misc.: A major focus point of the department has been to have positive public relations, and to create strong professional working relationships with surrounding departments.
