Tennessee Respite Coalition (TRC)

- Offer a respite care reimbursement program for individuals who are full-time live-in caregivers
- Caregivers may be eligible for up to \$600 dollars per year in reimbursement
- The TRC also coordinates with a third party organization to provide Senior Companions. These companions are free of charge to you and will come to your home so you can leave for a couple of hours to take care of yourself.
