What is Synapticure?

This is a virtual care team for patients and caregivers who are currently living with progressive neurological diseases such as Parkinson's, ALS, and Alzheimer's. This virtual care team coordinates directly with your current care team at your local hospital. The goal of this service is to bring fast access to expert treatment from the comfort of your own home. This service is **not** meant to replace your home hospital care team but is meant to work along side of them as needs arise.

Who Is on the Virtual Care Team?

- Care Navigator - nurse or social worker who helps to coordinate everything you need. They are available 24/7 and will work as your personal advocate
- Specialty Neurologist - provides treatment, diagnosis (if needed), and brings new perspectives to the latest research and ultimately strengthens your care team
- Wraparound Services - these include speech and language pathology, physical therapy, and occupational therapy
- Genetic Counselor - has a deep understanding of each person's disease and can aid in tailoring specific treatments as well as can identify potential clinical trials that the patient may be eligible for
- Behavioral Health Team - consists of psychiatrists, psychologists, and social workers who work to meet the specific needs of each patient and care partner
- Community - Individual and group support from other patients and care partners

How Is Synapticure Different?

- Appointments When You Need Them - appointments can be scheduled in less than 4 weeks compared to the multiple month long waiting list at your home doctor's office. When a new symptom or concern arises, the Synapticure team can get you into an appointment much faster than you can get in to see your home hospital team. Synapticure provides care that bridges the gap between appointments with your neurologist/movement disorder specialist.
- The Care Team - nearly every person, physician, and therapist on the Synapticure care team has previously cared for someone with a progressive neurological disorder. They have been in your shoes.
- Care for Care Partners - the synapticure team works around the schedules of the care partners. Appointments happen virtually from the comfort of your home and can be easily scheduled when it works best for you and your loved one.

Paying for Services

- Your first consultation with Synapticure Care is free
- Synapticure accepts Medicare and they are In-network for most Insurance plans
- The team will work with you to navigate your benefits and access to care
- On average, most in-network visits cost between 0 and 40 dollars
- For those who qualify, financial assistance programs may be available
