(the "**Association**"), do hereby certify that at a meeting of the Board of Directors of the Association (the "**Board**") duly called and held on the 3 day of April, 2023, with at least a quorum of the Board members being present and remaining throughout, and being duly authorized to transact business, the following First Amendment to Architectural Guidelines for Meadow Lake, Sections One (1) through Seven (7) (the "**Guidelines**") was duly approved by a majority vote of the members of the Board:

RECITALS:

1. The Guidelines were recorded under Clerk's File No. RP-2023-50315 of the Official Public Records of Harris County, Texas.
2. The Board desires to amend the Guidelines to prohibit painted brick.
3. This First Amendment to the Guidelines has been approved by the requisite vote of the Board of Directors.

AMENDMENT:

Article IV, Section A(5) is hereby added to read as follows:

5. **Painted Brick.** Painting the brick on the exterior of a residential dwelling on a Lot is expressly prohibited.

All other provisions of the Guidelines shall remain in full force and effect.

I hereby certify that I am the duly elected, qualified and acting President of the Association and that the foregoing amendment was approved by a majority vote of the Board of Directors as set forth above and now appears in the books and records of the Association.

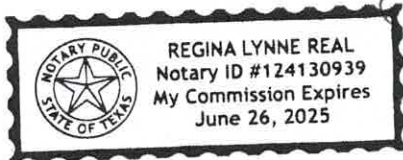
