So many of us have had our worlds turned upside down and our hearts go out to all who have experienced loss over the past year. After a period of daily changes in spring 2020, we have now settled (if you can call it that) into weekly and sometimes monthly change.

This year marked the first summer since our inception in which we have had to cancel our festival activities. Gathering all of our artists and audience was unsafe even though, in hindsight, Manitoba's pandemic risk was relatively contained at that point.

I am incredibly proud of our staff. Despite no public performances in August, we created our first film/miniseries. Green Envelopes was a massive achievement for our fledgling company and we are so grateful that people tuned in to watch our miniseries.
