

SER Jobs For Progress Training Program for Internships

We will be adding new requirements for in-school and summer internships for all Automotive Technology Programs with whom we have established work experience agreements.

Jim Click Automotive Group, Royal Automotive Group and Desert Toyota will be providing Express Lane Service Training using online courses. These courses will be accessed through the Dealerships. Each student must have at least (1) ASE Certification and completed Dealership Express Lane Service Training to be eligible for Internships.

Teacher Responsibility

1. Automotive students must select a 1st and 2nd choice preferred Franchise. (Note: Students 1st and 2nd preferred franchise selection will be initially considered, however may not be assigned based on overall placement availability) Training programs from the following:

The program. Modules will consist of Express Lane Service training online courses. These must be completed before hand-on internship.

2. Generate a list of students with the following information; student name, home address, phone number, last four of SS#, email address, please forward the information to arthurb@susd12.org for a training assignment.
3. The timelines for completing the Express Lane online training is (30) days from the date of assignment. Failure to complete them will result in removal from the program and lose their internship.

4. Teacher buy-in. It's a win; win for our Auto Programs and Auto Industry. This means Dealership Certification in High School, a program we've been looking for. This will help your A-F letter frame for your School District if the student completed a (120) hour internship.

Student Responsibility

1. Complete all online Express Lane Service Training.
2. You have (30)days to complete your Dealership Training. You will not be considered for the paid internship if you do not complete your Dealership Training.
3. You must have ASE Certification and Dealership Express Lane Service Certification before you receive your Work Experience Internship.
