Rain Shadow Artisans goals include:

- To provide support and venues for local area artisans to exhibit and/or sell their designs;

ARTISAN CATEGORIES:

Artisans

Those who design and create products by their own hand from new, natural or upcycled materials. No commercial, imported, or second-hand items allowed.

Prepared Food Artisans

Those who offer food products that have been personally prepared/processed on property they own or lease in Washington State

Fresh Food Artisans

Those who offer freshly made foods available for sale and immediate consumption.

Youth Artisans

Artists who are age 17 or younger are highly encouraged to participate and will receive mentoring to help build a business career in the arts.

Every artist is partner of Rain Shadow Artisans and is a valued participant of our community. We encourage the sharing of ideas for growth and success.

We are recognized as an IRS 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization and are an all-volunteer organization managed by a Board of Directors

Fees include: * Initial Sign on \$100 * Annual Renewal Fee TBD

- * Event Fees based on event costs, minimum \$35/event. Please ask about youth fees!
- * Some fees are subject to change and are openly communicated annually.

JURY PROCESS

All prospective new artists are required to attend a jury meeting.

This meeting is an informal exchange of information, where you introduce products and learn about Rain Shadow Artisans.

Why do we jury artists?

- 1. To maintain a high standard of quality
- 2. To ensure products are handmade by applicant artist.
- 3. To create a varied produce selection for our events.

Artisan Criteria

- 1. **Handcraftsmanship:** How much of the item the artist responsible for?
- 2. Artistic Skill: Is the item well-conceived? Does it present a mastery of the medium?
- 3. Original Design: Is each item an original design or patterned using a template? Is it crafted? Is it assembled?
- 4. Quality: Do items present professionally and of high quality?
- 5. Market Enhancement: Item presentation is key, photos are required.

What sets us apart from other venues?

- 1. We do not charge a commission for artists sales;
- 2. While we encourage participation, we have no minimum attendance requirement;
- 3. We strive to showcase high quality and to promote local artists;
- 4. Marketing our artists and events for great visibility to invite guests and entice excitement.
