

Confirmation Saint Report

As a part of your preparation for the sacrament of Confirmation, you will write a paper on your chosen saint. The saint you choose to research should be the one whose name you will take as your Confirmation name.

Your saint should be chosen based on one or more of the following...

- Shared traits of you and the saint
- Traits you wish to acquire as a person
- Your hopes for the future
- Patron saint of your interests/hobbies/possible career path

Requirements for the paper are...

- Basic biography information such as
 - Birth/death, dates and places
 - Family life
 - Occupation
 - Anything you feel will give a good idea of who the saint was as a person
- What major world events happened during this saint's life
- What you would argue is their greatest impact on the world
- Why you chose this person to be your Confirmation saint
 - This should be a large part of your paper and should include serious thought before writing. Answers should be *thoughtful* and *genuine*.

Length should be around 1-1.5 pages (double spaced).

Please head this assignment as follows

Saint Essay

Name (first name, Confirmation name, and last name)
