Early Easter

It's been 8 years since we've had a March Easter. March Easters show up occasionally, usually once every 4 or 5 or 8 years or so. Most of us have experienced it being on March 23rd – back in 2008. (I'm thinking that may have been the year we have a picture of our boys and our nieces hunting for Easter eggs in the snow.)

We have also experienced Easters in late April, like in 2011 when it fell on April 24th . (There could have been snow that day also, but it's a bit less likely.) For various reasons, the date of Easter is based on when the full moon falls in relation to the Spring equinox. Easter falls on the first Sunday after the first full moon after the equinox, which is on, or about, March 21st .

However, I'm looking at it a little differently right now. Maybe Easter is showing up in March because, somehow, we are in need of Easter.

Easter has been looking at our world, at all of

us who are in it, and at all of the situations we have gotten ourselves into. Easter looked down and saw the wars and the viruses. Easter got wind of our polarities, our divisions, our struggles, and complaints. Easter took a good long look at the state of things and decided that we are in need of some hope and some relief.

So Easter marshalled the forces – sent the clouds to cover the sky on February 2nd so that the groundhog would miss his shadow and spring would be ordered up early – checked in with the Moon and arranged for her fullness to arrive with the worms on March 25th – as Easter still prepares to arise on wings with Alleluias and lilies and the rosy fingered dawn along with all the glory of the Sun on March 31st, bringing with it joy and hope and singing, the promise of new life, and the end of death.

Easter is having mercy on us, arriving early so that we can be fed with hope and feel joy. So that our lives can be renewed.

Show your appreciation to Easter and pay attention. Prepare for Easter through prayer and worship, through remembering our need for God and God's mercy and strength and goodness in our lives, through remembering Jesus – not just his resurrection, but his rejection and death out of love for all of us, to show us how to live and how to love one another. And then out of the despair of Good Friday, and the darkness of Holy Saturday, celebrate the new life given to us on Easter Day – just a bit earlier than usual.

Consent Agenda Items

January Minutes

Meeting called to order by President, Les Gumieny.

- Each member introduced themselves.
- Each member was tasked with listing 3 goals believed to be vital to the life of the congregation. Each member's goals are to be emailed to the President before the next council meeting. At the March Council meeting we will consolidate and select goals for the year.
- Linda Spencer volunteered to serve as Council Secretary.

Pastor Update

- Council members will be installed February 18, 2024 at both services, except for Mark Ehleiter who will be installed February 25, 2024.
- **Bylaws discussion.** NCLC needs to develop a new structure to replace the current cluster structure. The clusters reported to Pastor Brad. It is believed the newly formed committees should report to individual council members.
- We reviewed Chapter 12 Congregation Council of the NCLC Constitution.

Worship Update

- The Ash Wednesday service will be held on February 14, 2024 with the Imposition of Ashes.
- Lenten services will commence February 21, 2024. The Lenten meal will be from 5:30 to 6:30 pm with the Lenten service following at 7pm.
- Pastor will be gone March 10, 2024. Ann has arranged for a substitute.

Stewardship

- Needs work! Forming a group to work on stewardship. Stewardship is evolving to a year-round process rather than just a fall campaign.

Financial Update

- An update provided by the 2023 Treasurer was read. The update disclosed NCLC has received in January 2024 the most income it has received in a January in 5 years. The entire 2024 insurance bill was paid in January. Therefore, the January expenses exceed the January income. The transition of the Treasurer duties from Nathan to Maggie is in process.

Committee Updates

- Fish Boil: Tentative thoughts for the Fish Boil were discussed.
- Golf Outing: The Golf Outing Committee requested Council input for selecting a financial goal to receive Golf Outing funds. This discussion was tabled until next month to enable the Property Committee to finalize a plan for the renovation of the Church front steps.
- Property: We have done well this year regarding snow removal expenditures.
 - NCLC has a new mailbox after a driver demolished the old one. The driver came to the church to reimburse NCLC for the damage he caused.
 - Property will meet this month to finalize the plans to refurbish the front steps.

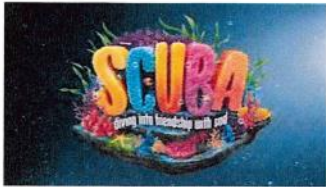
