### Where Are You Rooted?

"I am the true vine, and my Father is the vinegrower.

<sup>2</sup> He removes every branch in me that bears
no fruit. Every branch that bears fruit he prunes to
make it bear more fruit... <sup>4</sup> Abide in me as I
abide in you. Just as the branch cannot bear fruit by
itself unless it abides in the vine, neither can you unless you abide in me. <sup>5</sup> I am the vine, you are the
branches. Those who abide in me and I in them bear
much fruit, because apart from me you can do nothing." John 15:1-5

We are the branches to Jesus' vine, and as followers of Jesus, our purpose in the world is to bear the fruit of Jesus with our lives. And we are to bear that fruit in all of the ways and places that God has given to us to bear it – in our families, in our jobs, in our communities, in all of our relationships, and yes, even in our churches.

The fruit we are to bear are the "good works, which God prepared beforehand to be our way of life." (Ephesians 2:10) Or, as St. Paul names them "love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self control."

(Galatians 5:22-23) It is by being connected to Jesus, to the vine, that we are given the gifts and the strength to bear the fruit of Jesus. And the more we are connected to Jesus, the more and better fruit we will bear.

Now, the point I want to get at here is that by having our lives being fed by Jesus, being connected to Jesus' vine, or rooted in Jesus, we grow in the good works that God desires for us. There are lots of things that we are fed by in our world. If we continue the vine or root metaphor, we can think of ourselves like portable branches that can be hooked up to various vines, or our roots can be pulled out and transplanted into different soils repeatedly.

And so, we have to be aware of who or what is feeding us in our daily lives. Where do we move our branches to, where do we plant our roots? Living in our world, it's not really possible to be connected to Jesus' vine all of the time. We will be listening to our families and friends, to the music and programming around us, the things we watch, the books we read, the politics and philosophies of our culture. All of these things also feed us, our roots are often in these other soils.

We need, as followers of Jesus, to make sure that our roots get into the soil of Jesus, that we are regularly hooked up to the vine of Jesus. We can do this through worship, prayer, Bible reading, giving of our lives—whether it is our time or energy or money—to be used as God would have them be used. All of these things, and any other way in which you practice your faith in Jesus in your life, are ways in which we make sure that we are rooted in Jesus.

And the more rooted we are, the more we will learn to live as Jesus would have us live. We are branches, and we are here to bear the fruit of Jesus.

Consent Agenda Items March Minutes

Meeting called to order by President, Les Gumieny.

Consent Agenda Item: March Minutes approved

Les updated Pastor Robb on the goal priority list discussed at the March Council meeting.

#### **Financials**

March 2024 donations exceeded March expenses by \$6,002. March revenue was high, \$28,518. Note: Easter was March 31 and therefore included in those numbers.

#### **Pastor Update**

MET: The MET Team's MSP will be done in May. A Town Hall will be scheduled with the Synod office after the MSP is complete. On April 28 a meeting is scheduled between services to receive congregational input on the 5 areas NCLC would like the new pastor to focus on. These areas will likely need congregational assistance.

By-Laws Update: Pastor provided a brief over view of the newly updated by-laws. The by-laws are written by the Congregation therefore they can be changed by the Congregation. The by-law numbering structure corresponds to the Constitutional Numbering Structure. Chapter 12 details Council information. C12.01.02 is newly added. It states "Prior to serving on the council, members of North Cape Lutheran Church shall have been members of the congregation for at least 12 months." C13.02.01 provides Nominating Committee guidance. C13.06.01 details the proposed new committee structure. An Outreach Committee was not included in the structure. This committee can be added later if desired. C13.06.02 states the Cemetery Board and WELCA will operate their own board members and checking accounts.

Linda Spencer made the motion to schedule the Congregational Meeting for June 2, 2024 to ratify the by-laws and the Constitutional changes. Amy Stillson seconded.


