2. Request for additions or changes to agenda - none

5. Captain's Report - Captain Gordon Read; we are at over 70 Cadets, with 2 more tonight. We have been asked to participate in the Light Up The Park down in Devon, depends on the dates if we will be able to attend.

## 6. Executive and Committee Reports

Chair Report - Kristina Millican; Kris and Mark have been working hard on the new website and to keep it up to date. Please make sure everyone is checking the website, including your cadet.
-Get screened to volunteer to help out with cadets and to transport them. The more that are available and screened, the easier it is to volunteer. It's a very easy process, please see our Volunteer Screen Coordinator to get a letter to get your vulnerable check done at the RCMP.
-Holiday Potluck was so much fun last year, we will be holding it again this year! -We will be having a pub night on April $13^{\text {th }}$ and we are looking for items for the silent auction and sponsorship. We are looking for volunteers to help organize the event. It will be held at the Trax in Spruce Grove. Kathleen will be sending out emails over the next few months. -A tab has been added to the website called "How can I help", once you click on it, you will see that we've added some ways that you can help without donating any time and money.
The first one is our brand-new CO-OP number. Anytime you go to CO-OP to fill up with gas and you wish to use our number instead of yours, the proceeds will go to the squadron. Maybe make it a habit, once a month. It's an easy way for you to donate!

FlipGive is an easy-to-use cashback app for teams, designed to raise funds while shopping for the things that you're already buying from your favourite brands. There is a huge list of gift cards that you can purchase such as Sobeys, Home Depot, Walmart, Amazon, Starbucks, etc. For each gift that is purchased, the Squadron will get a percentage back. So next time you go grocery shopping purchase an online gift card before leaving the house. You will be able to redeem it at the store or online! It's as easy as that!

-We did a Bones Tournament/ Ball Tournament in July, it was good, very busy and very profitable.
7. Financial Report - Jason Kennedy; last year's books are finished up, Sept $1^{\text {st }}$ to Aug $31^{\text {st }}$. We had a loss last year without a casino. Total expenses last year were $\$ 50,000$. A normal year is around $\$ 45,000$, and we only had $\$ 20,000$ from fundraising last year. More cadets equal more expenses. A casino needs to last about two and half years. We will be in the black this year with the casino.
-There was a trip planned to go to Greece about five years ago and there is money in an account for it. We would like to move the monies into the general account.
-The profit from the $50 / 50$ was approximately $\$ 1159$, that was drawn at Wing's Parade.
