





The Fr. Thomas A. Judge Knights of Columbus hosted their 7th annual Patriotic Family Night' on Monday, November 20th at their hall in East Northport to recognize and pay tribute to local veterans. Thirty-five veterans, representing all the services and every major U.S. military engagement from Pearl Harbor to Afghanistan and Iraq, shared their experiences with the more than one hundred people in attendance. The program opened with Past Grand Knight Frank Collins presenting a special tribute to our flag and how the Knights of Columbus led the effort to add "One Nation under God" to the Pledge of Allegiance.

Guest speakers included Mark E. Capodanno who gave a stirring presentation about Fr. Vincent R. Capodanno, a U.S. Navy Chaplain who, while serving in Vietnam, died heroically in a hail of machine gun fire rushing to the aid of several dying Marines and a Navy Corpsman. Fr. Capodanno received the Medal of Honor posthumously and is being considered for canonization as a Saint of the Catholic Church. U.S. Navy 1st Class P.O. Morty Roberts, Spoke about his WWII experiences and what it was like after the Pearl Harbor attack and the end of the war after Hiroshima. Larry Brown who served both in the Navy and the Marines shared his extensive war-time experiences in Vietnam, and also in Iraq and Afghanistan. Former Army Sgt. Robert E. Lee who served in Korea in a non-combat role, mentioned how humbled he was by those who served and risked their lives to protect our freedom. Lt. Col. (ret.) John Carvajal served during the Gulf War and discussed how his unit provided needed supplies to enable U.S. forces to quickly expel Iraqi troops from their occupation of Kuwait. Former Navy SEAL Lt. Dan DeBono, who also served during the Gulf War, explained what he learned during Navy SEAL training that helped him never give up and quit. He was one of 22 SEALS out of a class of 100 to make it through the grueling training regimens. Tim Scherer, father of USMC Cpl Chris Scherer who died from sniper fire while serving in Iraq, spoke about how

Gold Star families are true patriots dedicated to making a lasting impression in the lives of our current service members, deployed military families and the veteran community. K of C member, Dr. Ray Mascolo DDS, who served in the NY Guard, related his involvement with feeding the homeless vets at the Northport VA Medical Center. Madeleine Gelles-Mistretta spoke about her late father's overseas service during WWII which was highlighted by scrap books she helped him organize prior to his passing.

As a memento of the occasion, K of C Grand Knight Richard Ronde presented a certificate to each veteran commending them for their service. The program concluded with the playing of TAPS in memory of all those who made the ultimate sacrifice serving our country.
