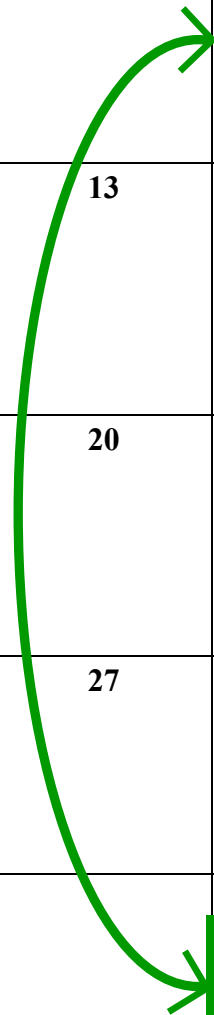

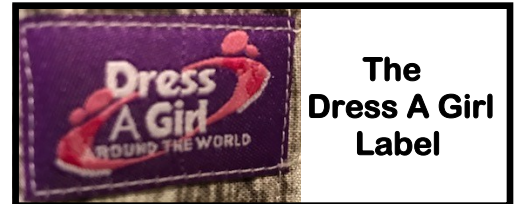
# Fr. Judge Columbiettes Dress a Girl Program

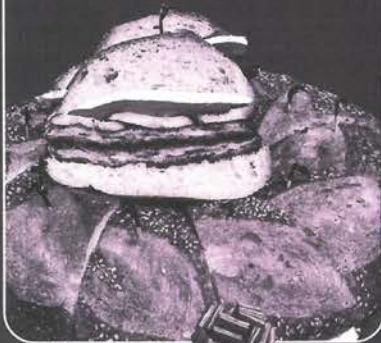
