Grand Knight's Message, October 2022 Knight Light

My Brother Knights, friends and family,

I would like thank you all for all your hard work and dedication for making September and every month successful and rewarding. We had several council activities and events during the month, including joining other ministries of St. Anthony of Padua to celebrate a special person in our Parish.
