# Veterans Night “A Tribute to Our Veterans”



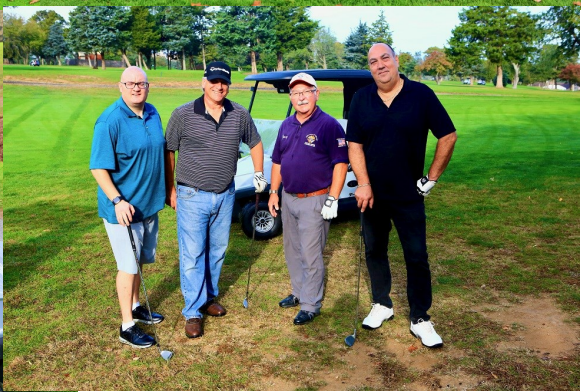

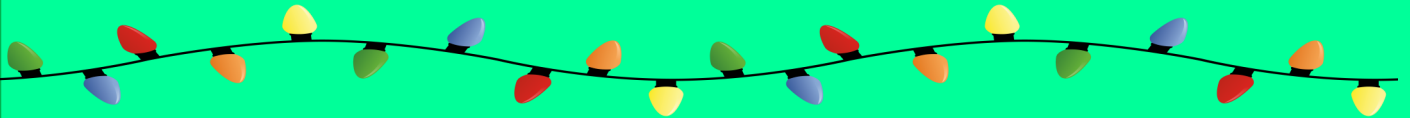


## **Council Tree Lighting Tuesday, December 7th 7:00pm, Lower Church**

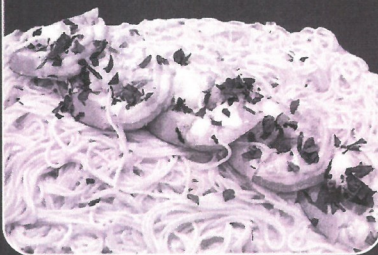

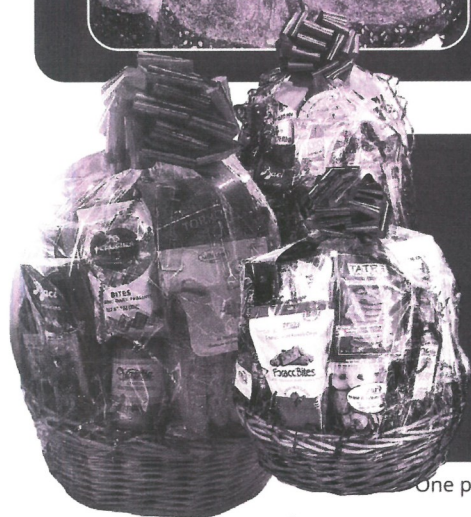
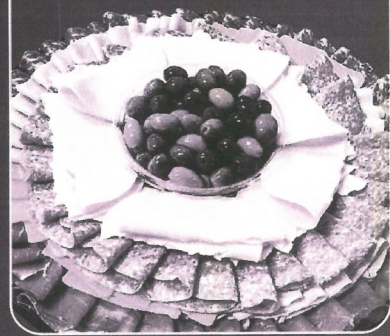
