## Grand Knight's Message, November 2023 Knight Light

My Brother Knights, friends and family,

Wow! It's November already!

Thank you all for making October another successful month. Another busy month for the council, if not directly but indirectly, because several brothers are involved with other Church and Community events.

On Monday, October 2nd, we had our Council Business meeting. That night our Worth District Deputy, William Murphy, presented the Council with 2 awards for the 2022-23 Columbian Year. The Council was honored with The Founder's Award, an award given for meeting insurance goals and the Fr. Michael McGivney Award, for meeting membership goals. Brothers these awards were a direct result from your dedication and hard work. In particular the McGivney award, the council recruited and exemplified 16 new members last year – Thank you!, a number I hope we can achieve again. On Friday, October 6<sup>th</sup>, the Annual Flu Shot clinic was held in the lower church of St. Anthony of Padua. 37 vaccine shots were administered. Thanks to our Lecturer Ray Mascolo, our second guest speaker, from the Suffolk County Police Department, spoke about being prepared for emergencies when in a public setting (i.e. Church, shopping mall & airport). On Wednesday, October 18<sup>th</sup> the Council hosted the Our Lady of Fatima Assembly (4<sup>th</sup> degree/Patriotic degree). ## Father O'Leary Scholarship Winners

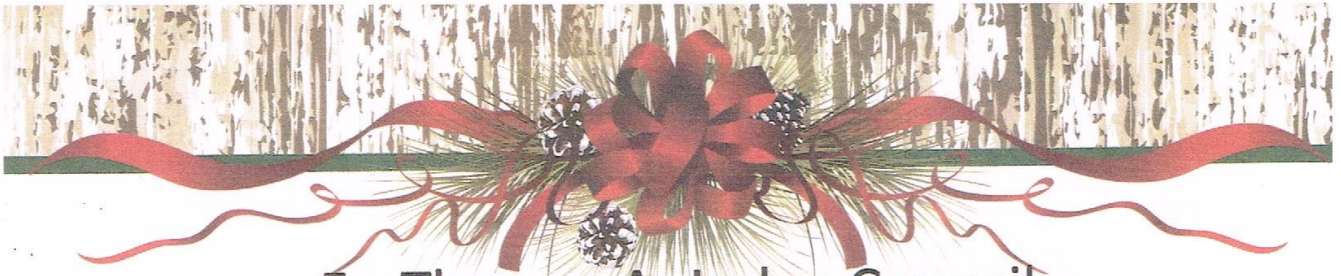

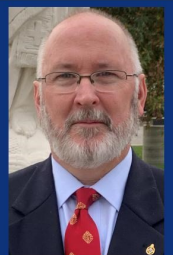
