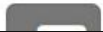

When you click on a course you're taking, you'll see the course dashboard, which shows any recent class updates and any scheduled events/assignments in the next week. This page includes a bulletin board, which is public to all students in the class.

The **Syllabus** page is where course information and the syllabus will be. Once you're registered for a class, you can access the syllabus page and see anything that is posted on it, including your syllabus (syllabi are usually posted 3 months before a class starts). On the right side, the instructor can post links, your required books, and course files (assignments, supplemental reading). Some instructors will use all of these Populi features, while others may not. One useful thing about Populi is that since you have to login to enter the site, we won't have to password protect files posted there.

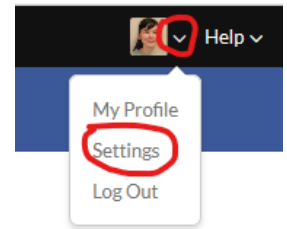
