A Message from Faithful Navigator Joseph Ch'ien

Vivate Jesus! We had an active month in April. Our Sir Knights participated in a total of nine full uniform turnouts, including five District and four local turnouts. Our delegates attended the Fourth Degree Biennial District Meeting on April 13. We took part in the Knights of Columbus Texas State Convention in Houston on April 27-28. Congratulations to our dedicated Color Guard team who represented the First District of Texas in the Color Guard Competition held at the Convention on April 27 and placed Third. Thank you Sir Knights for the service and dedication!

We will elect Assembly 2084 officers for the Fraternal Year 2024-2025 at the Assembly meeting on May 2. Article VIII, Section 23, of Laws and Rules Governing the Fourth Degree of the Knights of Columbus states: "Annually, each assembly shall elect a Faithful Navigator, a Faithful Captain, a Faithful Pilot, a Faithful Comptroller, a Faithful Scribe, a Faithful Purser, Faithful Inner and Outer Sentinels, a Faithful Admiral and a three-year Trustee. The Faithful Navigator, Faithful Captain, Faithful Admiral and Faithful Pilot shall annually appoint a priest to act as Faithful Friar or Chaplain but such selection must be made in accordance with any rules established by the bishop of the diocese in which the assembly is located. The Faithful Admiral shall be chosen from the Past Faithful Navigators of the assembly, if any there be." A digital copy of this Laws and Rules is attached to this newsletter for members to familiarize with the roles and responsibilities of the assembly officers. I would like to encourage all our Sir Knights to participate in the elections and serve as officers. It is a fulfilling experience serving members, the Fourth Degree, and the Church. If you are interested in serving as an officer, please contact me before the May meeting.

The Summer Fourth Degree Exemplification will be held on June 22, 2024 at Sts. Simon and Jude Catholic Church in The Woodlands. Any Third Degree member of our Councils who wishes to become a Fourth Degree Sir Knight will need to complete the Fourth Degree Membership Document (Form-4). Completed Form-4 must be submitted to the upcoming Assembly meetings for membership approval.

We are Fourth Degree Sir Knights of the Knights of Columbus. We are faithful to our Order, Church and Country. I would like to encourage all of our Sir Knights to become active members of the Color Corps and serve as the visible arm of our Order.

A Reflection from Deacon Allan Frederiksen

Justin, a child of Greek parents, was born in Nablus, in what is now the West Bank, about AD 100. He is known in the Greek as Ioustinos ho martys. He is also known as Justin the Philosopher.

In about 155 AD he wrote a letter of "Apology" to the Roman Emperor Antonius Pius, asking the Emperor to stop the persecution of the Church. This letter is part of a series written to explain to the Emperor the Christian faith, the true faith.

For the sake of space and time, only a small part of the letter will be presented here, but in it we will recognize the early celebration of Mass.

I have added *Italics* as a simple explanation of some of the events Justin describes.

"On the day we call the Day of the Sun (pagan worship by much of the Roman world), all who dwell in the city and in the country gather in the same place. The memoirs of the Apostles (The Gospels and The New Testament Letters) and the writings of the prophets (The Old Testament) are read, as much as time permits (the Mass is not restricted to about one hour).

When the reader is finished, he who presides over those gathered admonishes and challenges them to imitate those beautiful things.

Then we all rise and offer prayers for ourselves and for all others, wherever they may be (*The Prayers of the Faithful*). Then someone brings bread and a cup of water and wine mixed together to the one who presides over the brethren. He takes them and offers praise and glory to the Father of the Universe, through the name of the Son and the Holy Spirit (*The Eucharistic Prayers*).

When he has concluded these prayers and thanksgiving, all present give voice to an acclamation (*The Doxology*) by saying Amen. When he who presides has given thanks and the people responded. Those we call Deacons give those present the Eucharistic bread and wine and water, and take the Eucharistic elements, the Body and Blood of Christ, to those who are absent."

COLOR GUARD

We encourage all Sir Knights to join our Color Guard. This core group represents the First District of Texas and is very dedicated. If you are able and willing, it is a very rewarding experience. SK Teddy Cuaping is a great commander of the Color Guard.

PURPOSE OF THE COLOR CORPS OF THE FOURTH DEGREE

The primary purpose of the Fourth Degree is to encourage active Catholic citizenship and foster the spirit of patriotism in members and the community at large. The Color Corps members exemplify all the principles of our Order;

Charity- by the gift of their time and energies necessary to practice, perfect and perform the ceremonials and sword drill:

Unity- by the united efforts of Sir Knights to practice and perfect a coordinated drill for the good of the Church and the Order;

Fraternity- by expressing an "Esprit de Corps," sharing a common desire for drill excellence and camaraderie, and

Patriotism- by performing precision drill as a salute to God and to the country and visually exhibiting a love for both.

COLOR CORPS DESCRIPTION

The Color Corps (C.C.) has two sub-groups, the Color Guard (C.G.) and the Honor Guard (H.G.). The Color Guard consists of the flag bearers and at least two members of the Honor Guard who escorts the colors. The Honor Guard consists of members of the Color Corps who have mastered the Manual of the Sword.

In many assemblies, all members of the Color Corps belong to the Honor Guard. This should be kept in mind when following the procedures in the Color Corps Manual.

The public appearance of Fourth Degree knights as a Color Corps at religious and civic functions is an important activity for each assembly. They add dignity and the pride of Church and country to any event. By these public demonstrations their loyalties bring credit to themselves and to the Knights of Columbus.
