Youth for Jath is pleased to offer 'Vimal- Mahadeo Scholarship' for HSC (Science) students from Jath Taluka.

### Objectives:

- To award a prize money to the meritorious and students belonging to economically weaker section of the society.
- To provide them better opportunities for higher education increase their rate of attainment in higher education.

### Scope:

- The scholarship is to be awarded to **FIVE** students selected from qualifying applications.

### Eligibility:

- Student who has passed Class XII (Science) exam in Year 2018 and is interested to pursue higher education supported by entrance test scores or confirmed admission for the higher education.
- The student must have secured not less than **70% marks** in the class XII (HSC Sci) board examination and not less than **75% marks** in the class X (SSC) board examination.
- The annual income of whose parents/guardian from all sources does not exceed **Rs 2.5 Lac only**

### Value of Scholarship:

- In total **Rs. 15,000/-** payable directly into the bank account of the beneficiaries.
- Rs 5,000/- for the first prize, two Rs. 3,000/- for second prize and two Rs. 2,000/- for third prize.

### How to apply:

- Complete the application form available from the school/college or Youth for Jath's website and send it to the address provided in the application form.

### Selection Process:

- We will take weighed view of XII/X marks; parent income, entrance score/higher education admission, and other academic achievements.
- No discrimination will be done on the basis of religion/caste or gender.

7. All questions must be answered. Do not leave sections blank. If a section does not apply to you, please indicate that it is not applicable (N/A).
8. If you have been offered a scholarship, government award any other financial assistance for your forthcoming education; please attach a copy of the letter notifying you of your award/loan.
9. Application deadline: the final deadline is **15 July 2018 (decisions finalised in the first week of August 2018)**.
10. We do not accept incomplete or late applications.
11. Applications can be sent as a hard copy or soft copy attached in the email with scanned copy of application form and supporting documents.
12. You will be notified by email or phone call only if you are selected for the Scholarship.
13. You will be awarded on **15 August 2018** during the Independence Day celebrations at Jath. The exact place will be notified later. We will notify you in case the award ceremony date is changed.
14. We may contact the applicant during the verification stage however; we cannot participate in any individual correspondence with applicants on the decision.
