Requirements for Shipping Foreign Soils to CERCO

- 1. 1,000 grams of soil is needed for Corrosion Analysis purposes.
- 2. Under a P330 soil permit, all shipments must be free from foreign matter or debris, plants and plant parts, and other macro-organisms, such as insects, cyst nematodes, mollusks and acari.
- 3. <u>Double bag</u> each sample with the appropriate Sample ID on each bag.
- 4. Put all samples inside a 5-gallon bucket along with CERCO's Chain of Custody (completely filled out) and a copy of CERCO's permit.
- 5. Prior to sending samples, make sure the bucket is completely sealed then tape the lid to the bucket.
- 6. Place an address label on the bucket to: **CERCO Analytical, Inc.** 1100 Willow Pass Court Concord, CA 94520
- 7. Attach an envelope to the outside of the bucket containing each of the following:
 - A copy of CERCO's Permit
 - A copy of a number permit label which shows "Delivered to", address, U.S. Department of Agriculture
