LIMESTONE COUNTY Emergency Services District #2 Commissioners' Regular Meeting December 8, 2021

A quorum was present and Paul Loeffler called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Attending members were: Randy Behringer, John Beall and Charles Eastburn. Attendees fro WLLVFD included: David Nobles, Lesa Nobles and Randy Denzer. Matt Groveton, Limestone County Emergency Management Director also attended.

Citizen's comments: Matt Groveton commended WLLVFD and the ESD for their commitment to the community. He stated that he did want to give any impression of overreach by his office.

Reading and approval of Meeting Minutes: The minutes of the November meeting were approved with a change related to the identification an apparatus. The mention of Vehicle 2502 was corrected to be 2505.

Treasurer's report: A transfer of \$10,000.00 was made from the Apparatus Fund to the checking account. Deposits of \$100.00 were made to each of the water supply companies to ensure a credit amount remained in the accounts from which payments could be drawn. A check for a new generator was written for \$6128.91. Total expenses for the month were \$11,560.31. VFIS (insurance carrier) will submit a change in our policies amount before our next meeting. The checking account balance at the end of November was \$26,589.30.

Service Provider's Report: There were 16 calls for response during the month. Nine calls for medical response and seven fire calls. The average response time was ten minutes and four seconds.

WLLVFD Training: A Wildland Fire training class was held with 24 participants.

WLLVFD Treasurer's Report: We are still waiting for the Tender in Ohio to be painted. The anticipated delivery time is February. The checking account balance at the end of November was \$14,590.36.

Equipment Report: All vehicles are operational. WireCom suggested an up-date in the radio in Vehicle 2506. The air conditioning belt and the cam sensor need replacing in 2506.

Grants: The Thornton VFD has donated 15 sets of wildland firefighting gear. WLLLVFD received a \$10,000.00 grant from the Texas Forestry Service to support future training. A request for another grant from the Texas Forestry Service has been submitted for a clothing cleaning system. It is anticipated that there will be an increase in fuel costs and fewer funds required for Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). Charles motioned to move \$2,000.00 from the PPE budget line item to Fuel. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

New commissioner: Charles made a motion to send Randy Denzer's name to the County Judge and County Commissioners with our recommendation that Mr. Denzer be appointed to the ESD's Board of Commissioners.

Budget Review: Based on recommendations from SAFE-D the ESD will perform a midyear budget review.

Adjournment: Randy made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously.
